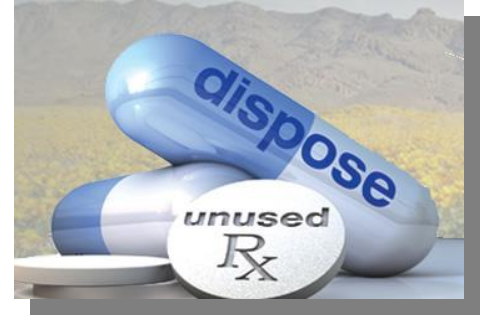

- Block out name for anonymity
- Do not cross out medication information
- Illegal drugs may also be dropped off anonymously
- Syringes and Sharps will be accepted

- No Chemo Drugs or Liquids of any type
